GOD'S STORY...

- Creation's Problem: Our **Sin**.
 - ▶ We are **guilty** before God.
 - ▶ We have **shame** before God.
 - ▶ We are **afraid** of God.
- The Creator's Resolution: His **Salvation**.
 - ▶ He **weeds** the guilty.
 - ▶ He **covers** the shameful.
 - ▶ He **protects** the fearful.

- Making our story **personal**...
 - ▶ How has God brought us from our sin to His salvation?
- Making our story **count**...
 - ▶ Keep it **brief**.
 - ▶ Keep it **simple**.
 - Three facets:
 - Simple description of who we were **before** we met Christ.
 - The fact that we came into a relationship with Christ.
 - Simple description of who we are **after** walking with Christ for a time.
 - Avoid the **drama**.
 - ▶ Keep it **focused**.
 - God is the hero of the story, not **us!**
 - ▶ Keep it **understandable**.
 - Avoid **Christianese**.
 - ▶ Keep it **humble**.
 - ▶ Keep it **clear**.
