 - **Disciples** of Christ with total world impact.
 - **Obedience** to God's command to reach the entire world.
 - An **abundant** life.
- ▶ We are **saved** for Christ's sake.
 - We **enjoy** His glory.
 - We **display** His glory.
 - We will **see** His glory.
